SUBJECT: Recommendation for Permanent Status of MS in ISTM

Dear Professor Johnson:

The purpose of this memorandum is to convey the recommendation from the Faculty Senate Graduate Studies Committee regarding the request for permanent status of the Master of Science in Information Systems and Technology Management and to provide some updated information. The Graduate Studies Committee unanimously recommends that this program be granted permanent status. The program has grown quite nicely since it began. We have added some information gained from the Office of Graduate Studies, which was not available when the department updated their program materials during the Permanent Status Program Review conducted last year.

The program had 6 applicants its first year. Applications continued to increase subsequently each year and reached 36 this past year of which 11 were accepted. An updated list is attached that shows matriculated students since this program began.
