Greetings, Randy. Back in 2011, you wrote a letter of support/approval for the grad students in the Medical Sciences PhD program to take BISC605 as an elective. That was before the KAAP dept discontinued KAAP654 (which we had included as a required science core) and went with your course for a cross listed KAAP615/BISC605 course. I now find that I need your dept approval once again for this since by our making KAAP615 required (in place of 654), we make 605 required.
