

Announcement of the pending retirement of a key faculty member in Fall 2014 led to concerns about the viability of continuing to offer the MAHP and thus, the combined 4+1 B.A in Public Policy and MA in Historic Preservation.

There are currently no students in the 4+1 program.

On May 22, 2015, the faculty of the School of Public Policy and Administration voted (12 yes, 4 no, and 4 abstain) in favor of a motion to not approve permanent status for the MA in HP but, instead, support the re-integration of HP as a certificate option within the MA in Urban Affairs and Public Policy.

WHEREAS the faculty of the School of Public Policy voted against supporting an application for permanent approval of the Master's degree, be it therefore

RESOLVED, that the Faculty Senate recommends that the combined 4+1 BA Public Policy and Master of Historic Preservation not be permanently approved.
