Twelve credits in advanced courses in a concentration approved by the student's CISC advisor and the CISC Undergraduate Coordinator.

Students are encouraged to explore how other subject areas impact and are impacted by computer science. Concentration courses must be distinct from other CISC requirements and technical electives.

In my opinion, these are "build your own concentrations", not approved by anyone but the advisor, and documented by course substitution forms with the registrar. I am getting a lot of "we have always done it" and "the registrar approved this", but I am having issue with it and I want the committee's opinions. CIS has program changes coming this fall.
