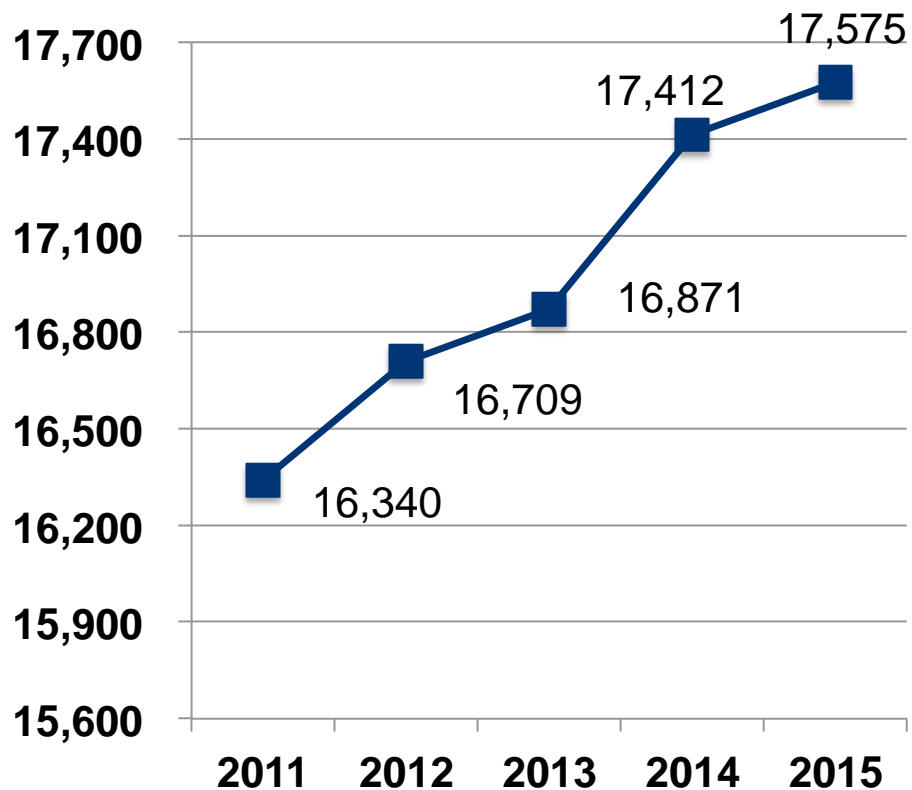

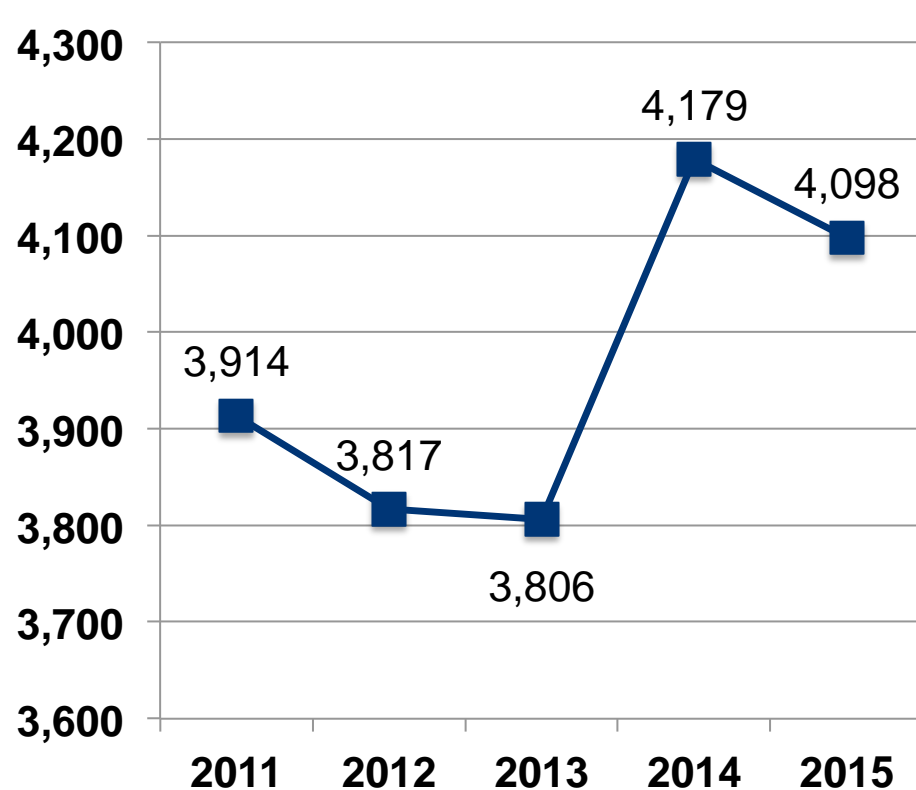

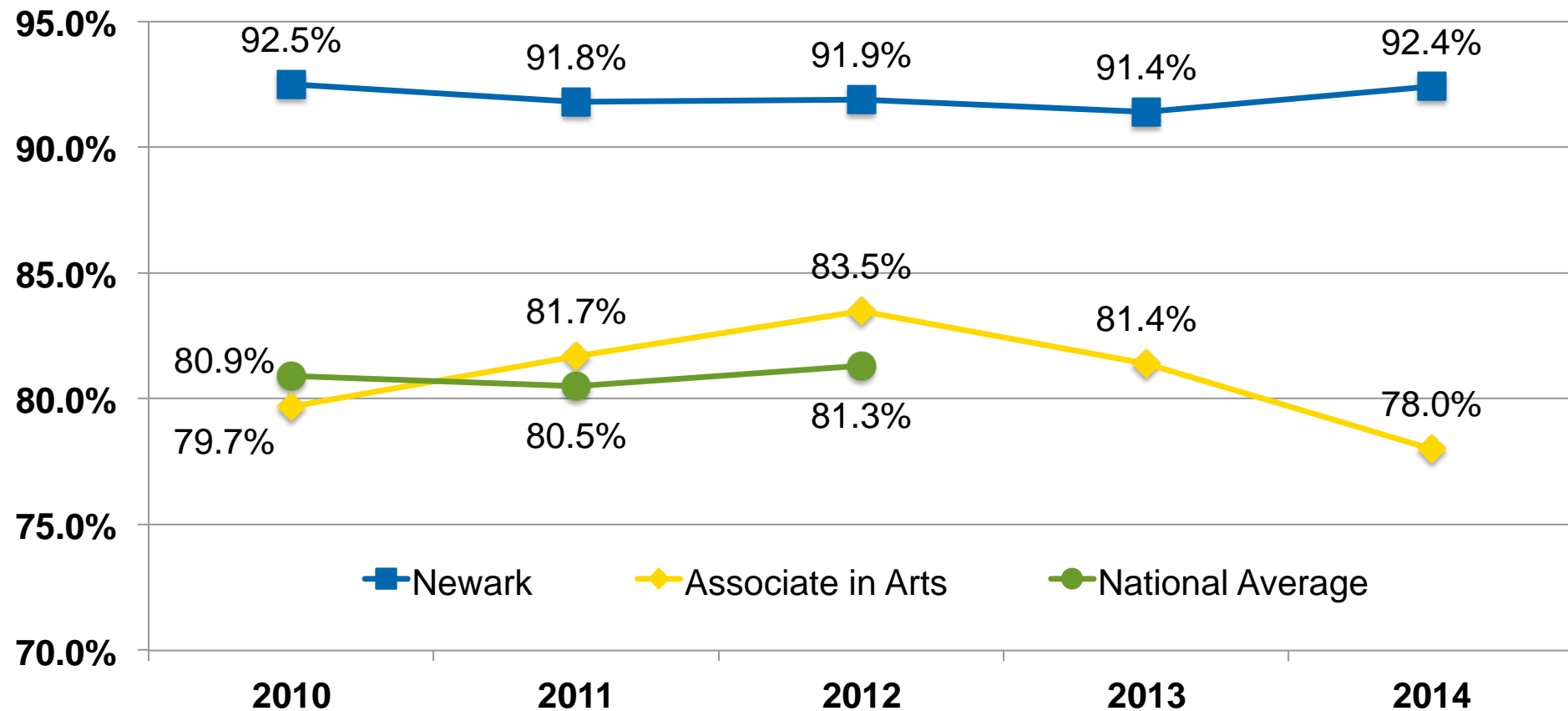

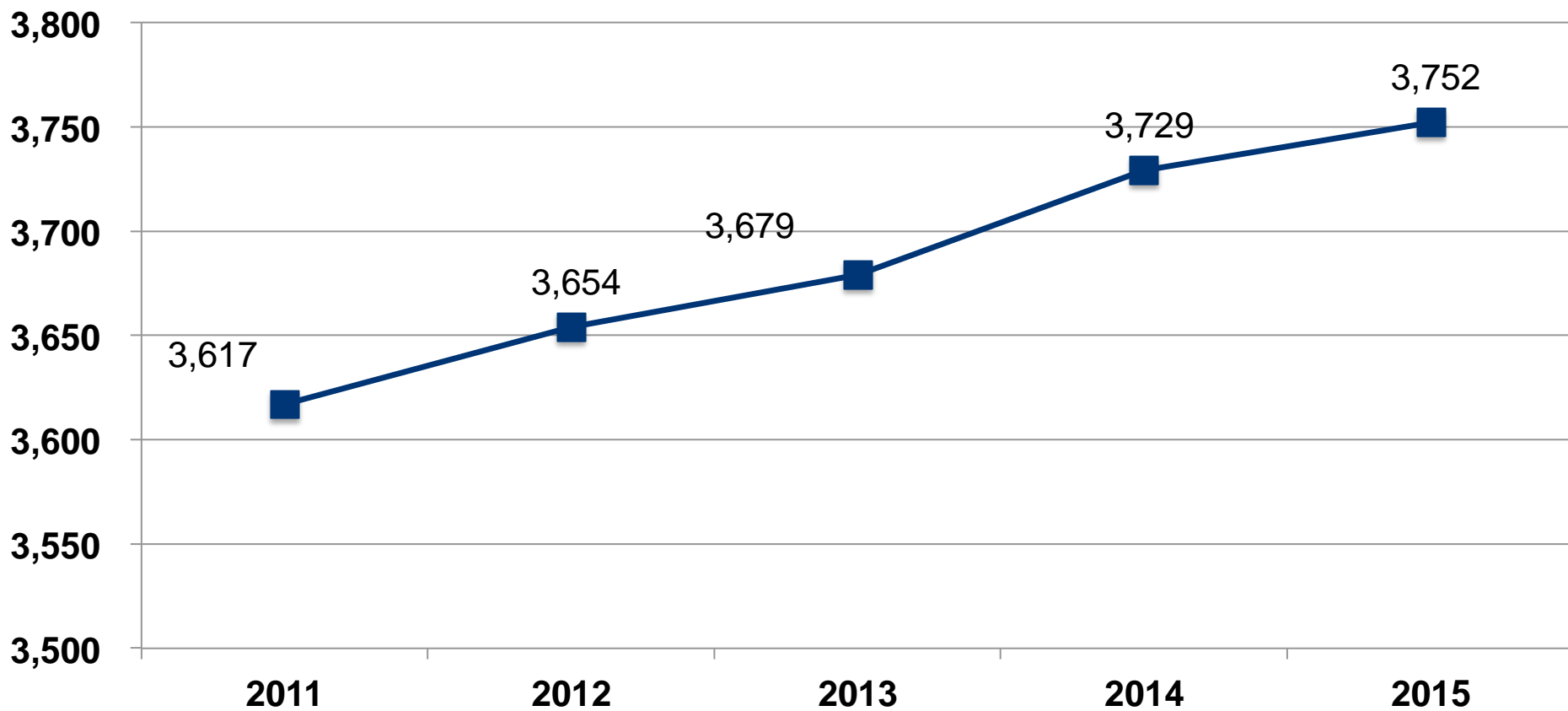
(First to Second Fall)

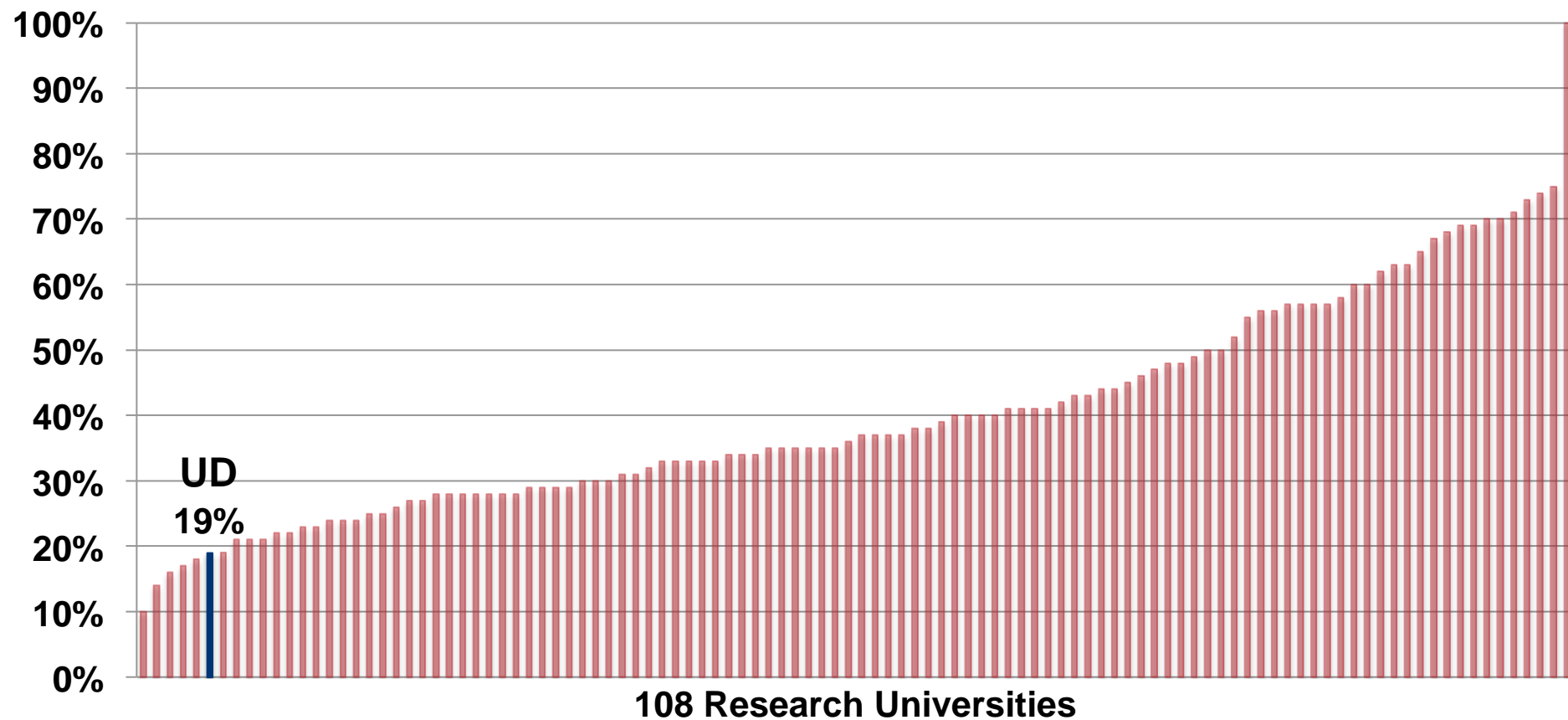

(% of all degrees, 2013)

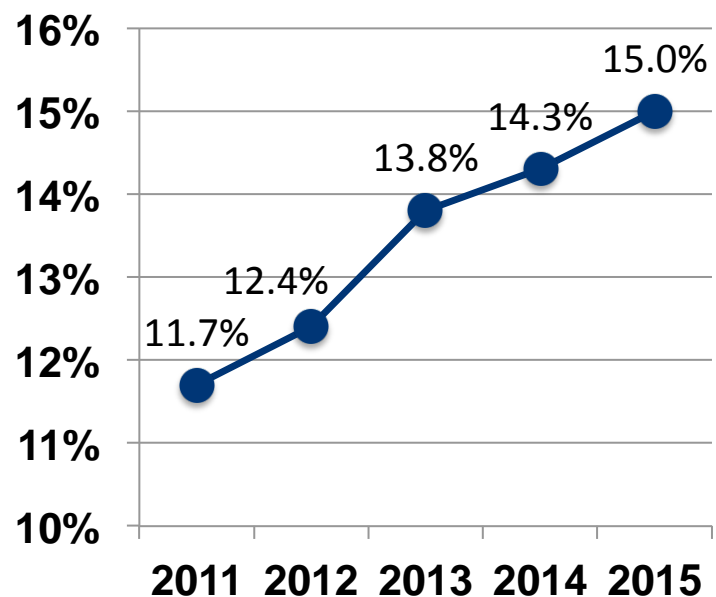

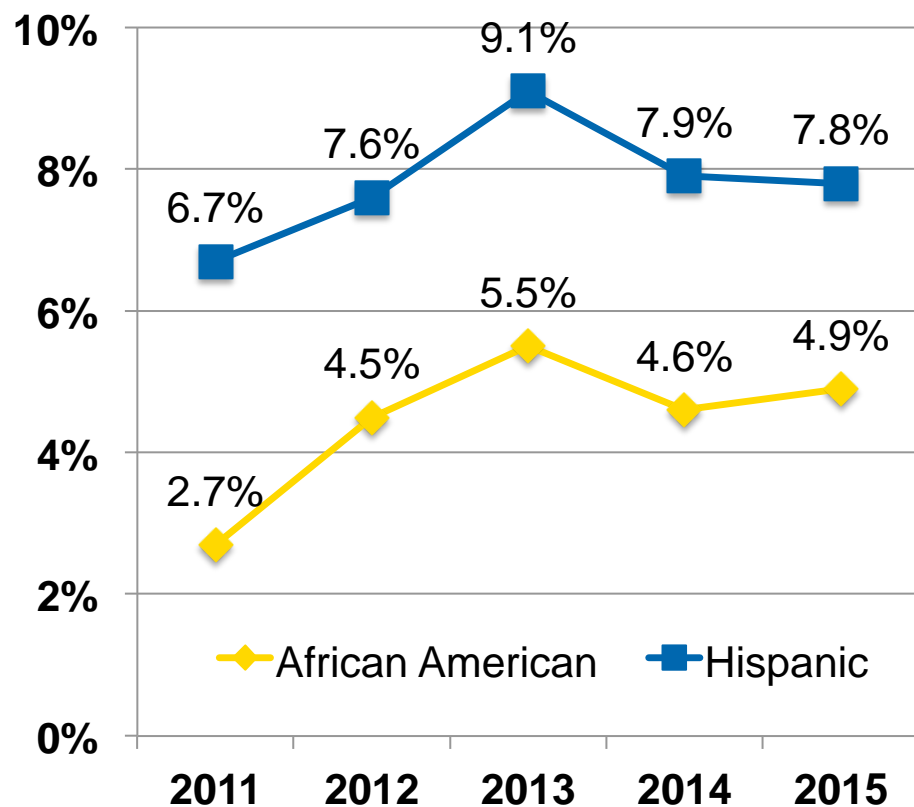

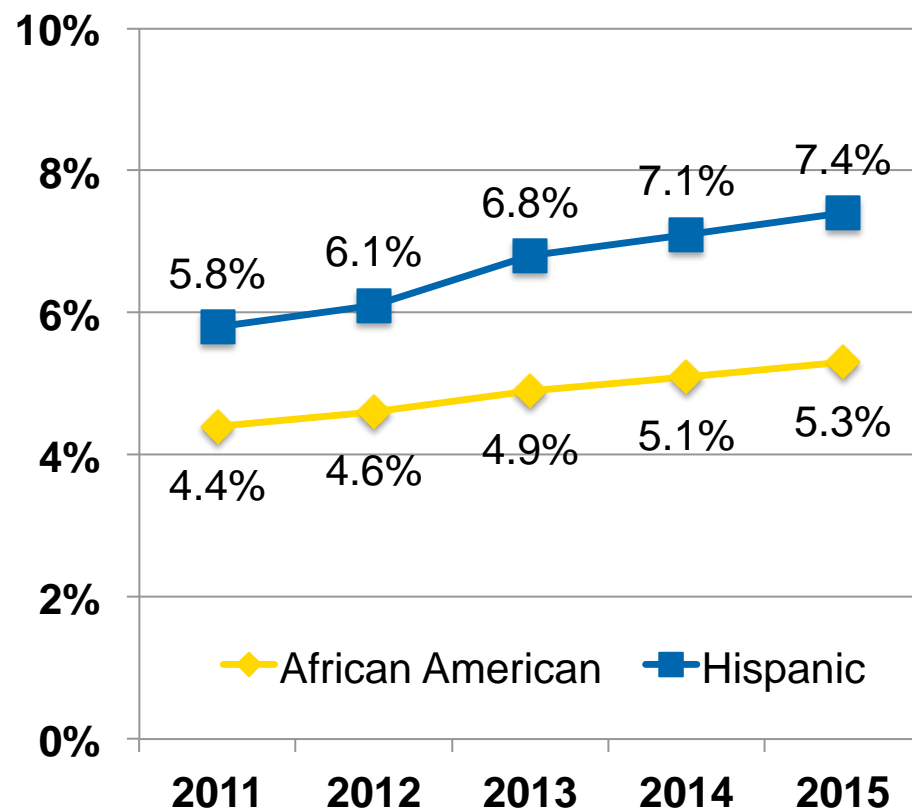

(Newark campus)

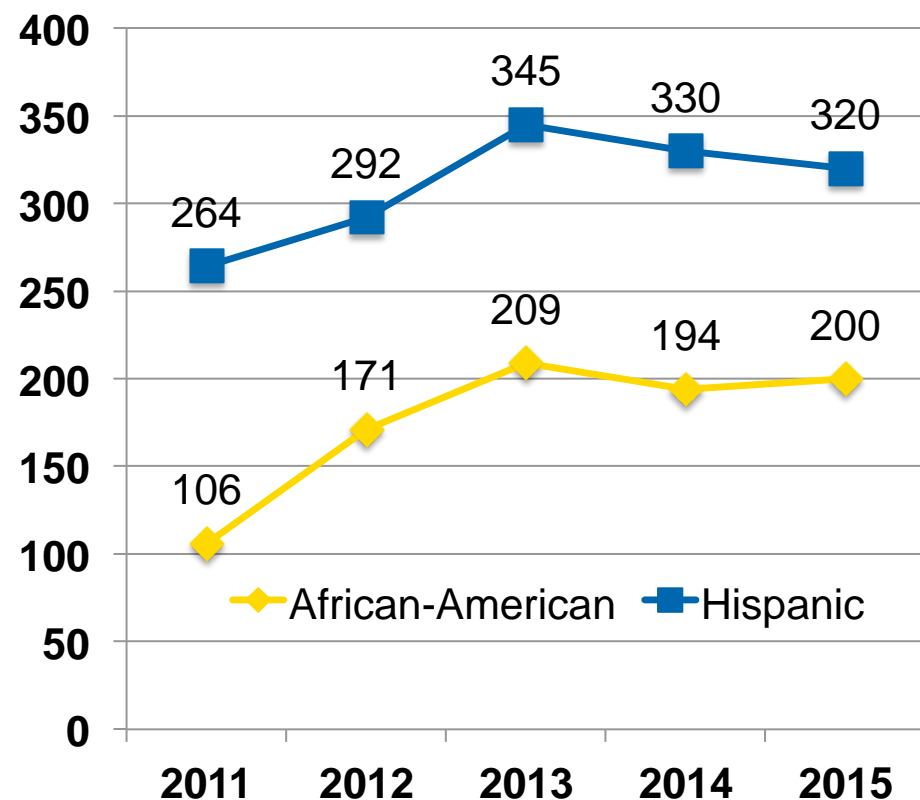


Undergraduate Minority Enrollment
(Newark campus)

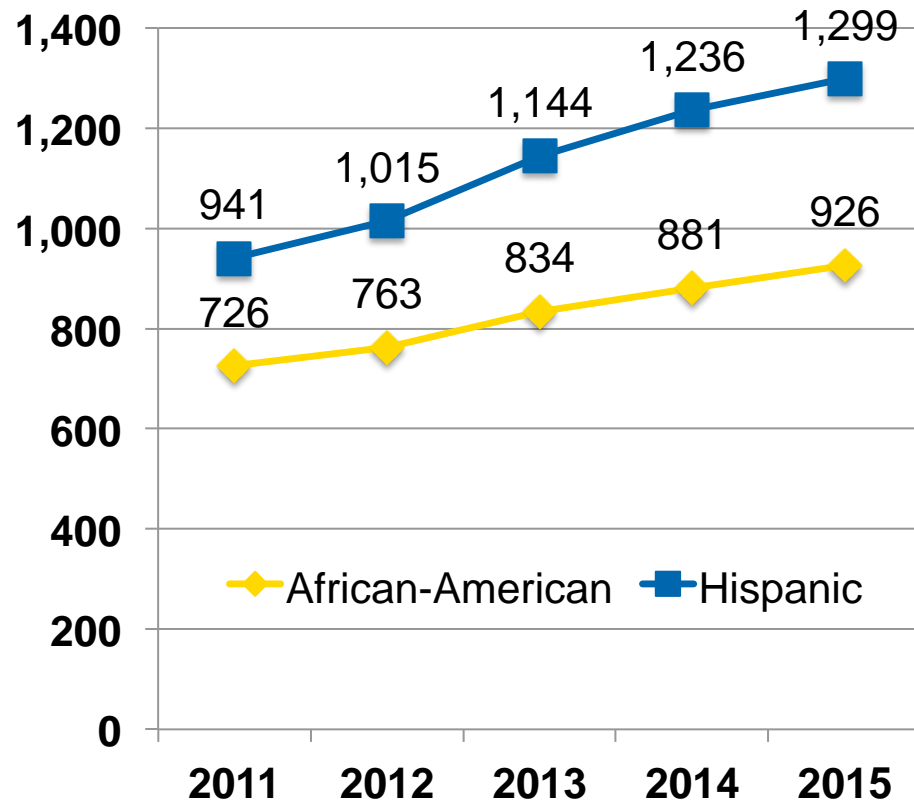

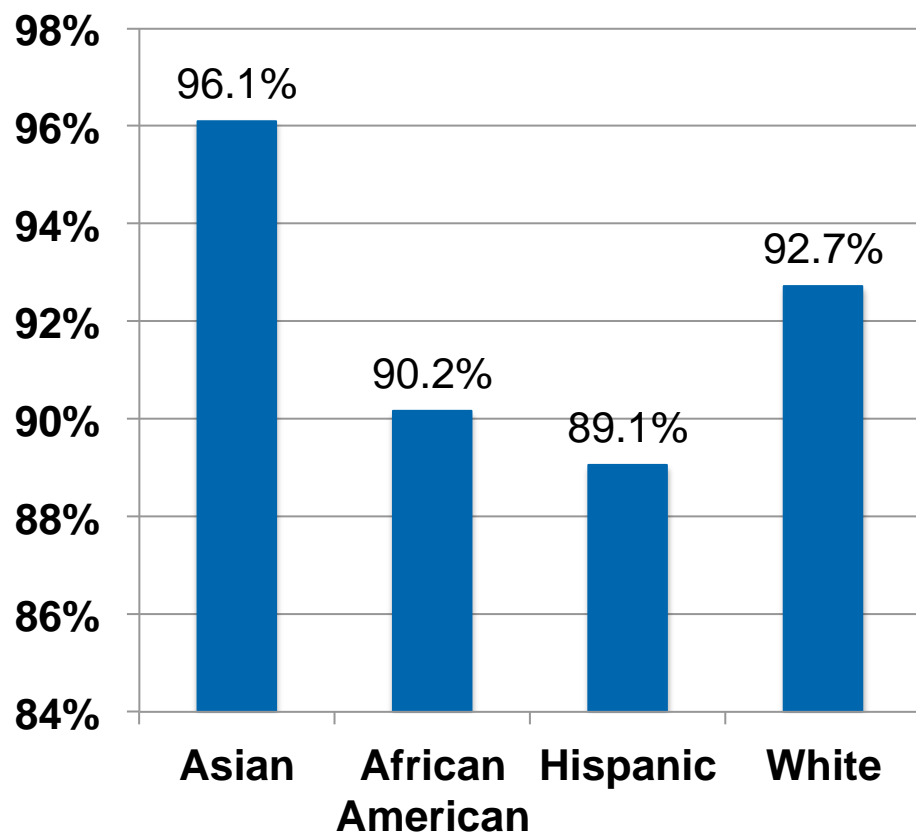

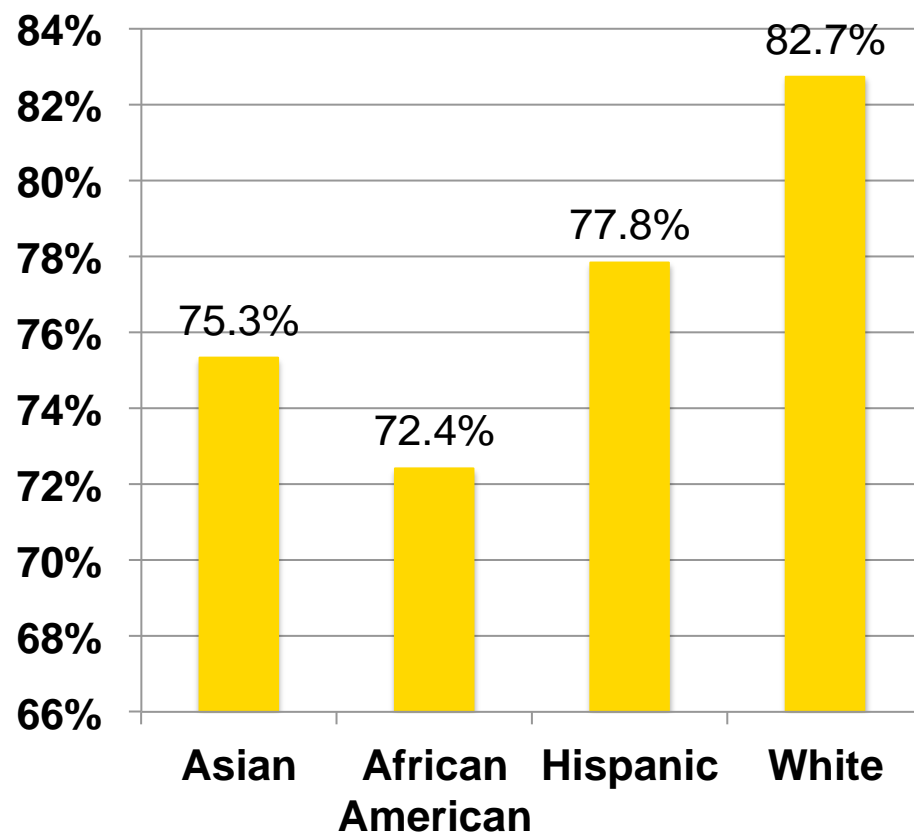

(2009 cohort)



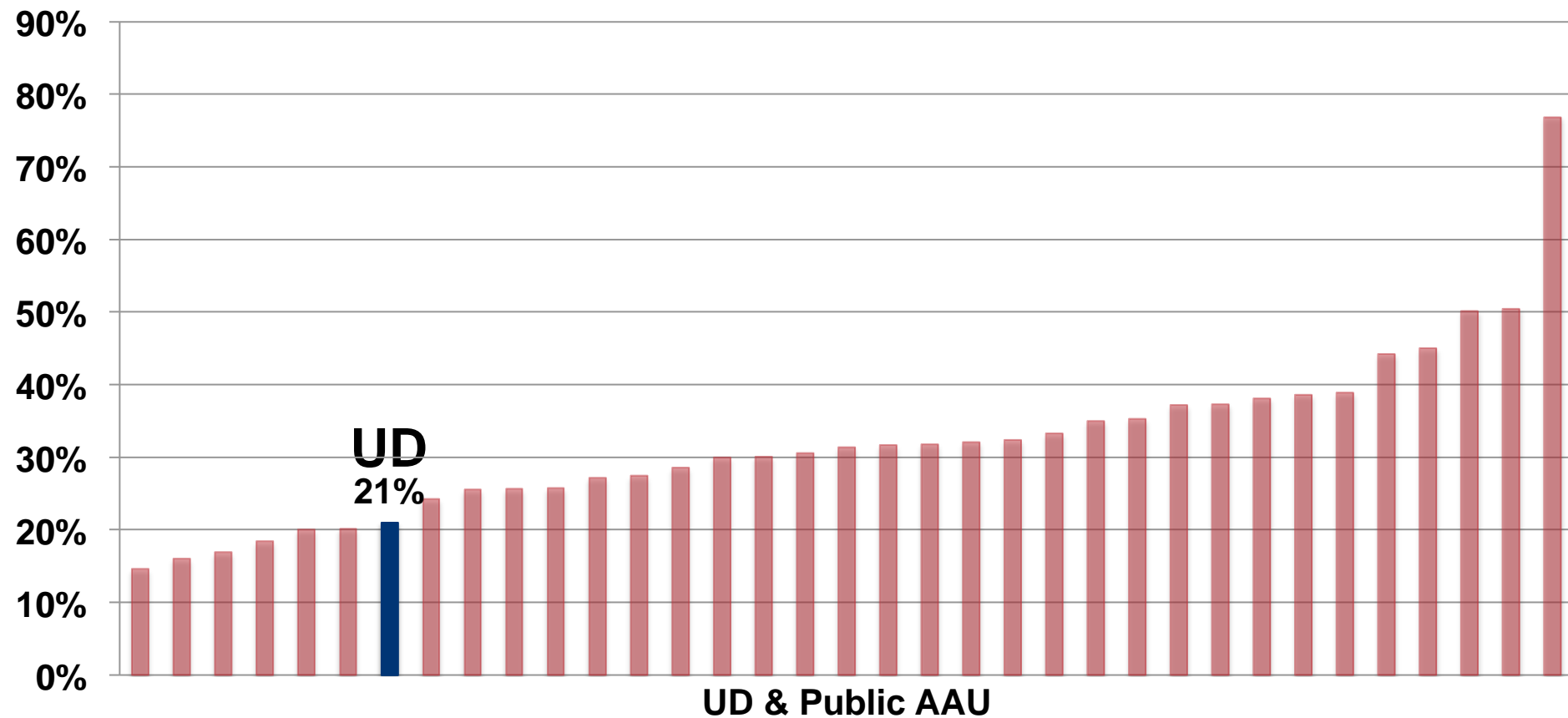

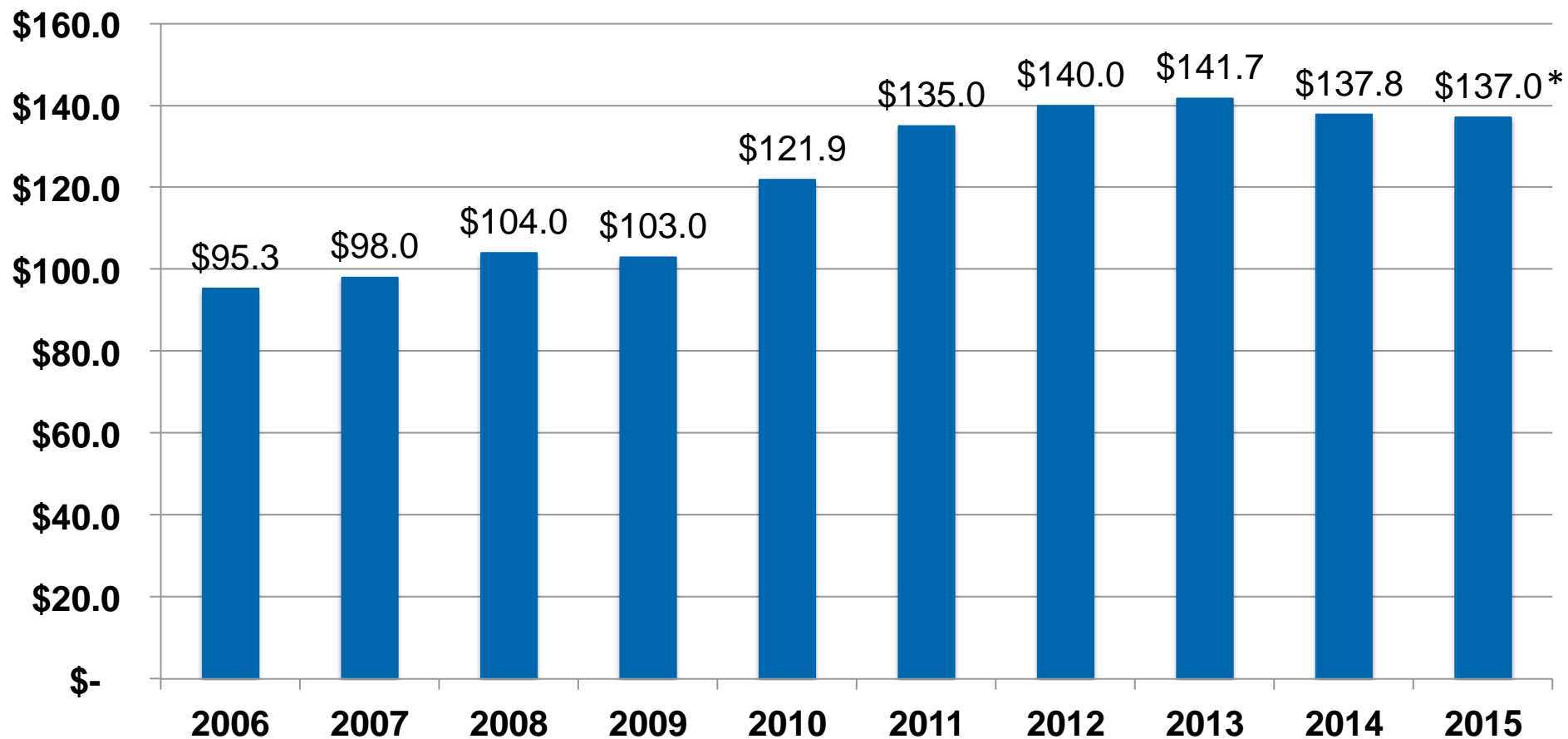
STEM degrees

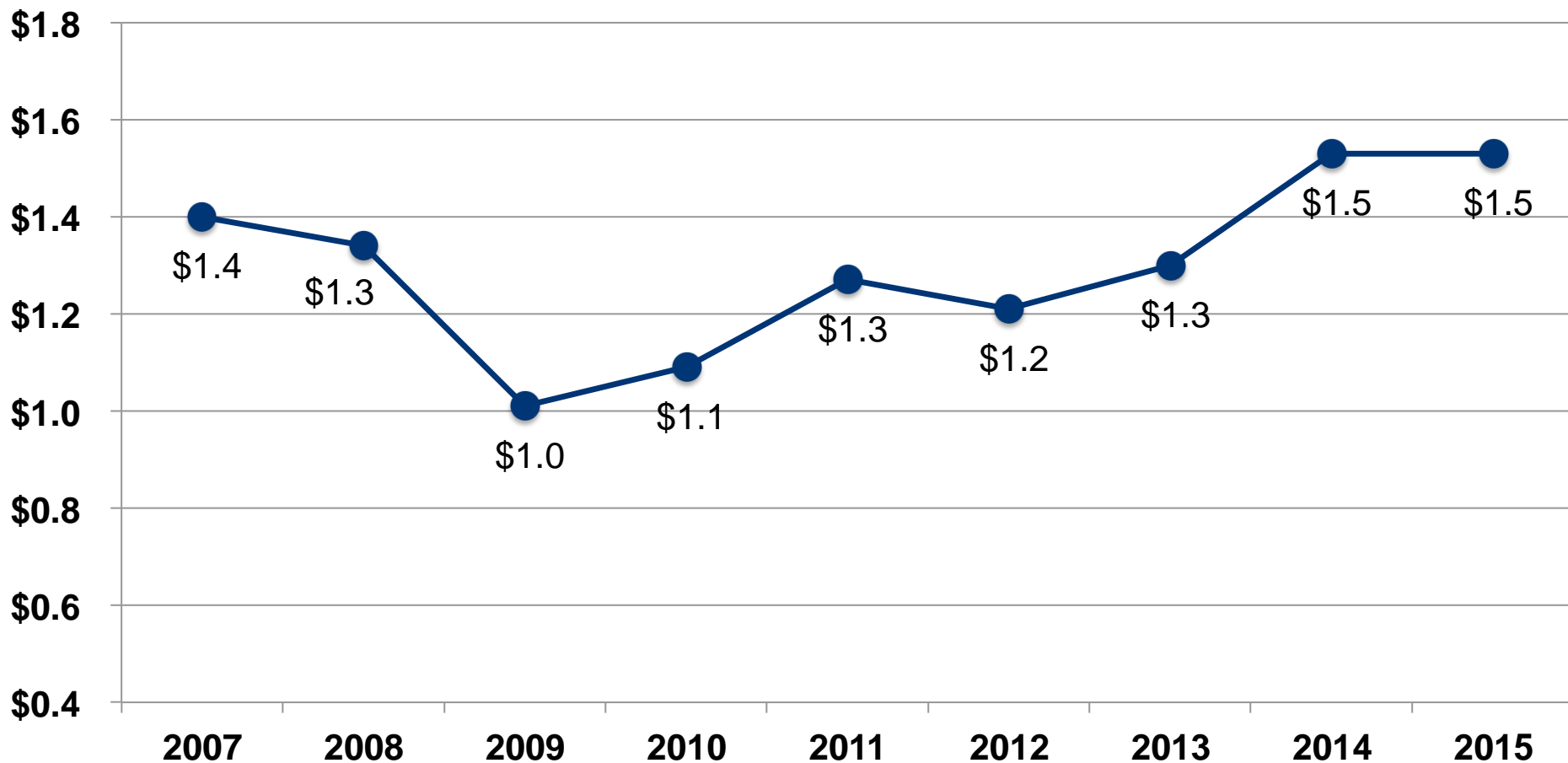

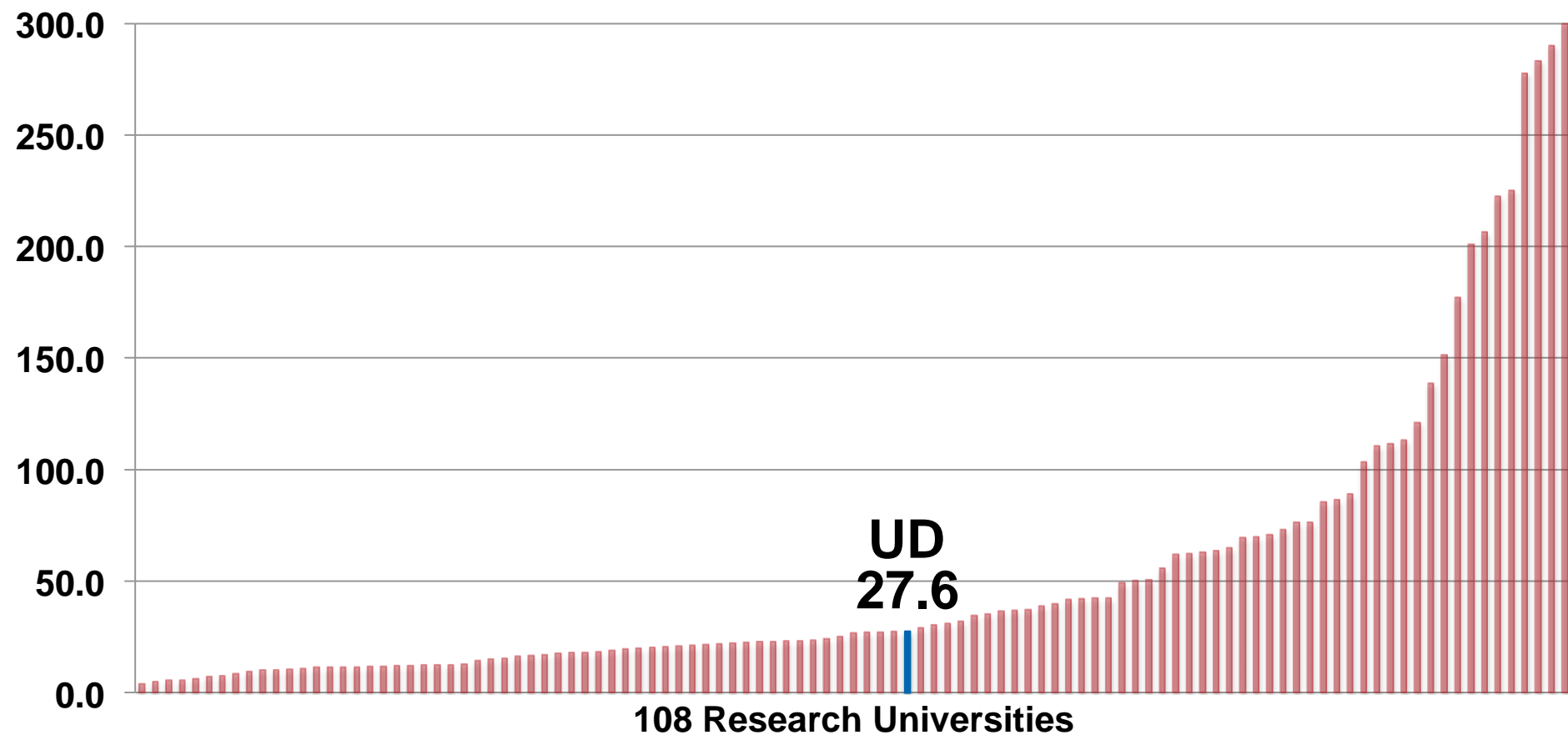
