May 21, 1970

ROUTINE PROCEEDINGS: Announcements, report of President Olson of visit with President Trabant to the Legislature, adoption of agenda, discussion of summer meetings.

BILLS INTRODUCED:

Disruptive Behavior Policy Report

S. Res. 17 (Faculty Personnel Policy Committee), Disruptive Behavior Policy Report, recommending a policy on disruptive behavior.

S. Res. 21 (Kramer), amendment to above. (Action taken June 1.)

BILLS REPORTED:

Disruptive Behavior Policy Report

S. Res. 18 (Halio), amendment to provide for faculty surveillance of security forces' action. Passed 28 ayes, 10 nays.

S. Res. 19 (Halio), amendment to provide sanctions against group action. Defeated 6 ayes, 35 nays.

S. Res. 20 (Kerner), amendment calling for prior consultation with the officers of the Faculty Senate before outside forces are called in. Passed 29 ayes, 16 nays.
